Through *In HER Words*, culturally diverse women who have found strength, joy and empowerment from traditions and families in their own cultures will present dance, songs, poetry and film derived from their stories and cultures.

Dewani Bakkum, the CEO of MARSS says: 'We often think that people have to leave their own culture to find models of strong women. However, many cultures have stories, dances and songs which created women's communities and a space for women to find solace and inspiration. This is what we want to showcase in this performance.'

Internationally renowned choreographer and former Canberra Times Artist of the Year, Padma Menon, is Artistic Director of the *In HER Words* project. Padma sees it as being about women taking pride in their own cultures and what inspires them— stories, dances, songs, poetry and role models.
